Basketball Tournament
4th – 5th – 6th-7th Grades



Roster form (players & coaches names with numbers) must be submitted by e-mail or mail as soon as possible or before December 1st so score sheets can be prepared in advance!!

NOTE: Coaches and/or players will NOT be admitted free if their names are not listed on the roster.
(Maximum of 10 uniformed players and 2 coaches)

ALL HIGH SCHOOL RULES WILL APPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENTS:

1. There will be two 16 minute periods with a continuous clock. The clock will stop the last minute of the second half. There will be a 3 minute halftime. Two 45 second time-outs will be allowed per game. The clock will stop for time-outs and re-start with the next "live" ball.
2. In case of a tie game there will be a 1 minute overtime. The OT will start with a jump ball. Each team will be allowed 1 timeout in OT. If game is still tied at end of first OT, teams will shoot a free-throw. First one to make after other team misses is declared the winner. A different player will be chosen for each free-throw.
3. The officials will beckon substitute players onto the floor on a dead ball handled by the officials.
4. The three point shot will not be used. NO ZONE DEFENSE. The free-throw line will be moved up 1 foot for 4th grade only. 10ft. basket height used for all divisions.
5. No full court pressing allowed in the 4th, 5th or 6th grade division, except during the last 2 minutes of the game. Full court press will be allowed for 7th grade but will be stopped after a 15 point lead.
6. Pool Tie breaker – head to head competition, then least points allowed / then coin toss.
7. Teams will be guaranteed three games.
8. A player may play on an older team. A player may play with only one team.
9. Coaches must turn in a completed roster to the tournament director for all players before the first game. Please email your roster in advance so score sheets can be filled out.
10. All players must have waivers signed by their parents before playing.
11. SPORTSMANSHIP IS A MUST. Coaches are responsible for their players' conduct both on and off the court. Please help to control the fans! Iowa Bench Decorum rule will be followed.
12. Absolutely NO CARRY-IN'S, food or beverages.
13. All games will be played at the high school located at 1325 9th Street SE, Dyersville. New gym will be available to all teams for warm-up prior to games. This gym is on north side of food area.
